### Under the UC-CONACYT Agreement

Financial support for up to 5 years of doctoral study at the University of California (UC) in almost all academic disciplines including the natural, physical and social sciences, and the humanities. Support includes:

- Non-resident tuition and fees
- Stipend
- Support toward health insurance

## General Requirements for the University of California

- Requirements vary by campus and department. Please visit specific campus and graduate program websites for more detailed information.

## General Requirements for CONACYT

- A minimum undergraduate GPA of 8
- A minimum TOEFL score of 550 (written) or 213 (computer)
- Outstanding academic, scientific, or technological skills
- Three letters of recommendation from professors or individuals who are qualified to rate your academic and/or professional progress

- Applicants do not need to have a Master's degree in order to apply for a UC doctoral program.
- Eligible disciplines include the natural, physical and social sciences, and the Humanities.
- Do not wait until the last minute to apply for UC admission or for the fellowship. We recommend that applicants prepare at least one year in advance.
